Short description

At the moment an increasing amount of events of different scale and nature (music, dance, protest, etc.) are being organised all over the world. In case of events which attract a large audience they can entail great risks for participants and spectators. In recent years a number of catastrophes occurred during events, such as:

- Love Parade, Duisburg, Germany
- Pukkelpop, Hasselt, Belgium
- Fireworks 14th July, Nice, France
- Festival, Ansbach, Germany



Recent experiences of events show that the characteristics and largeness of scale of events are not necessarily the most important measures for the magnitude of risk.

Growing terroristic threats complicate the assessment of licenses and permits.

Local authorities are confronted with a high responsibility to determine whether an event can proceed in the way the event organiser has planned. In the process of consideration the licensor should have to give attention to a large number of different associated aspects. In the effort to deploy this demanding responsibility, authorities urgently need guidance and support that helps them by finding the proper answers to the following:

- Possible risks
- Nature of those risks
- Their possible effects
- Measures to prevent
- Required capabilities and resources

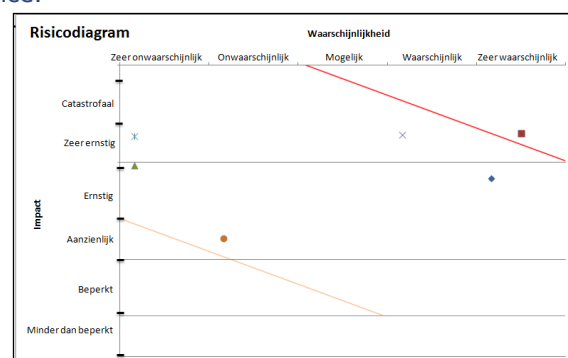
For whom?
